Privacy Policy

1. Who is responsible for the processing of your data?

The data controller will be the respective training entities to which you have subscribed to their workshop, whose details can be found on their respective websites, which are attached below (each of them, individually, will be referred to as the "Data Controller"):

2. What type of data is collected and processed?

The personal data processed by the Data Controller are those that you provide during the registration process to participate in the workshops and, where appropriate, during the workshops themselves.

In this regard, the personal data it processes for the purposes set out in the following section consists of contact information. This category of data includes, for example, your first and last name, address, telephone number, email address and other contact information.

3. For what purposes is data processed?

The Data Controller collects your personal data in order to manage your participation in the various workshops. Specifically, the Data Controller processes your personal data for the following purposes:

- a) Process your registration for the workshops.
- b) Manage your participation in the workshops.
- c) Sending of communications related to the organisation and development of the workshops you have registered for.

4. How long will your data be kept?

The Data Controller undertakes to process your personal data for as long as it is actually useful and necessary to fulfil the purpose of the processing.

In any case, and even if you request the deletion of your personal data, the Data Controller shall have the right to store and retain them, under the appropriate blocking, for the time necessary to comply with the applicable legal obligations, as well as to make them available to the competent authorities in the different applicable matters.

5. What is the legal basis for processing your personal data?

The basis of legitimacy for processing your personal data, according to the specific purposes included in section 3 above, will be the consent given for such purposes. Such consent has been given by means of a clear affirmative action when you voluntarily register for the workshop, which reflects a free, specific, informed and unequivocal manifestation of consent to the processing of data.

6. With whom will your data be shared?

Your data will not be disclosed to third parties, except to public bodies and authorities (administrative or judicial), provided that they are required to do so in accordance with legal and regulatory provisions.

Your data will also be shared with the Fundació Barcelona Mobile World Capital Foundation and with other companies that help to carry out the different purposes indicated in section 3 above.

7. What are your rights in relation to the processing of your data and how can you exercise them?

You have the right to access your personal data, as well as to request the rectification of inaccurate data or, if necessary, to request their deletion when, among other reasons, the data are no longer necessary for the purposes for which they were collected.

In certain circumstances, you may request the limitation of the processing of your data, in which case it will only be kept for the exercise or defence of claims.

Likewise, in certain cases and for reasons related to your particular situation, you may object to the processing of your data. In this case, they will stop processing your data, except for compelling legitimate reasons, or the exercise or defence of possible claims.

In addition, you may exercise your right to data portability, as well as withdraw the consent provided at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent prior to its withdrawal.

If you wish to exercise any of your rights, you can contact the channels provided for this purpose, whose contact details appear in the Privacy Policy in section 1 above.

Lastly, we inform you that you can contact the Spanish Data Protection Agency and other competent public bodies for any claim arising from the processing of your personal data, although prior to filing such a claim, you can always contact the Data Controller via the e-mail address provided in its corresponding Privacy Policy.
