


The Digital Future Society project impacts **six Sustainable Development Goals (SDG)** through the Think Tank's analysis and reflection and with specific, applicable solutions already developed by the Laboratory.

SDG9.Industry,Innovation and Infrastructure:

DFS proposes policies and incentives that create an environment in which SMEs can competitive innovative while challenging the traditional ways of doing business in the digital space. DFS experts provide a verification list to political leaders which enables them to identify a niche sector of companies working to increase trust and transparency in the digital economy.

SDG8: Decent Work and Economic Growth

DFS experts design specific initiatives to support workers on the digital work platform, such as establishing a cooperative platform accelerator administered by the government, sharing important information for workers and guaranteeing the clarity of the information provided on their rights and responsibilities.



SDG16: Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions: The DFS analyses and recommends policies that help governments use digital technologies to improve the quality and accessibility of public services, increase inclusion and access (SDG 10) and optimise processes in cities (SDG 11). Better governance and use of digital technologies particularly contribute to strengthening institutions. DFS offers an online interactive toolkit for the public sector to evaluate automated decision-making systems (ADMS) while considering and anticipating their social, economic and ethical implications.

SDG17: Partnerships for the Goals Governments and organisations have to work together to lower the digital divide (SDG 10) by making digital skills more important for people who are late technology adopters. DFS has created a two-layer platform of digital skills that provides:

- Digital skills for citizens to improve their quality of life (SDG10), and
- Professional skills so they can reap the benefits of access to the digital economy (**SDG4**).










The project is currently focused on the Global Technology Governance Summit announced for October/November 2020 in Barcelona. This is a bid on a state policy that implies a threefold challenge: relational, cohesion and financial (the minimum estimated budget is 1,800,000 euros to be co-finance between MWCapital and Fira de Barcelona).


